Alexander Prokofyev graduated with honours from the Department of Physics at Moscow State University (Lomonosov University). His main area of scientific research was on Cosmic Strings in Expanded Theories of Gravitation. Nowadays he conducts research in archeoastronomy, organizes and participates in observations of total solar eclipses, meteor showers and asteroid occultations. He has numerous publications in scientific and popular journals, and reports regularly on his work at National and International Scientific conferences. His talent in conveying modern scientific achievements and delivering knowledge to the public is held in high regard amongst amateur astronomers. He has given lectures in Russia, Ukraine, Germany, Finland and Cyprus.
